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


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Localized Agri-Food Systems : some definitions

- « production and service organizations agricultural and agro-food production units, marketing services and gastronomic enterprises, etc.
 – linked by their characteristics and operational ways to a specific territory » (inspired from Muchnik and Sautier, 1998)
- Analysis of social networks enhancing links between local resources, including agriculture, the food and the territory.
- More than just a location, a place-based activity, a group of interrelated territorial specific assets.







European Research Group LAFS

- In Europe, 8 countries and 36 institutions joined the ERG SYAL
- At the very beginning, the GIS SYAL created by INRA and CIRAD, and several universities in France
- Together with the Latin America SYAL network, 7 congresses :

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Meanings, Research Objects of SYAL

• 3 meanings :

- a **concrete object**, i.e. a group of visible agro-food activities territorially established

- a **conceptual approach**, a way of analysing *in situ* the development of identity based agro-food local resources and their systemic interactions

- an **institutional tool**, which can be used by administrative bodies and policy-makers in their planning programs.

• 3 main knowledge challenges :

- Understanding the nature and dynamics of the links (natural and material, sociotechnical and cultural, and socio-economic and institutional) between the main elements in a LAFS.

- **Specification of territorial resources** is fundamental to trigger the innovation process contributing to rooting production activities.

- Activating territorial resources and projects building up: the territory acts as a factor that connects, like a stakeholder with the qualities and the intelligence to organise collective strategies.





Processes of territorial anchorage of agro-food activities

- Identification of the **driving forces** of the LAFS evolution in time. Historical processes of localization/delocalization/relocalization
- Analysis of the effects of institution activity upon rural development Dynamics of territorial governance
- Understanding and feeding the learning processes among local actors Individual and collective strategies for enhancing identity-based products
- Research on LAFS requires interdisciplinary approaches / put together natural, bio-technical and social sciences






Place-based processes of production
